2010 Grants Information

Primary School:

Open 26 February 2010; Close 2 April 2010; Payment 31 May 2010;

- Not available to an individual student
- No application required, however, a report is required on deliverance of grant money received
- Primary school and grant value is still to be determined by the Grants Approval Committee.

Secondary School:

Open 31 March 2010; Close 30 June 2010; Payment 31 August 2010;

- Applicant must be of Tūhoe descent and registered on the Tūhoe-Waikaremoana Māori Trust Board Tribal Register
- Grant is available to students having to attend a private boarding school only

Diploma/Under-graduate:

Open 31 March 2010; Close 28 May 2010; Payment 30 July 2010;

- Applicant must be of Tūhoe Descent and registered on the Tūhoe-Waikaremoana Māori Trust Board Tribal Register
- Education grant is available to all tertiary students
- Te Rangihau Scholarship is only available to those students in their second year of study or more

Post Graduate/PHD:

Open 30 July 2010; Close 26 September 2010; Payment 15 November 2010;

- Applicant must be of Tūhoe descent and registered on the Tūhoe-Waikaremoana Māori Trust Board Tribal Register
- Applicants can apply for both the Tertiary Education grant and Te Rangihau Scholarship

Development Grants:

1. Open 8 February 2010; Close 31 March 2010; Payment 7 May 2010;
2. Open 30 July 2010; Close 26 September 2010; Payment 12 November 2010;

- Grants are categorised in Marae Development, Community Development and Research & Development
- Grants are not available to an individual or sports group

All grants are subject to applicant meeting criteria requirements and all applications are at the discretion of the Grants Approval Committee
